- The trainee pilot is obligated to follow the rules of the flying school for the entire duration of the training. Disregarding of
 the school conventions can result in expulsion from the training area by the flying instructor, whereupon all claims by
 the person concerned are invalidated.
- Flying outside the school without a licence is against the law and is strictly forbidden! Whoever undertakes the sport of flying without a license or outside of a flying school (also on the training hill) will be classified as a bootleg pilot by the police and may be charged. Additionally, in the case of any property damage, the insurance cover may be substantially reduced.
- 3. Paragliding is not a high-risk sport and is covered by normal accident insurance. In the case of accidents the flying school and the instructors accept no liability. In signing this document the trainee accepts this exclusion of liability and takes note that this also applies for continuation courses and changes in the course.
- 4. Damages to our training and test equipment, which are caused by the trainee, will be charged in full to the user. In addition, the trainee pilot has also to pay any costs of salvage charges or decrease of property values. A patronage of the REGA is implied. If not available and if there are any costs due to rescues, they have to be paid by the person who caused the damage.
- 5. The trainee pilot is responsible for good shoes and appropriate clothing. The flying instructor may refuse trainees with inappropriate shoes.
- The selection and payment of the chosen training option must be made <u>before</u> the beginning of the course. Subsequent changes of course are not possible. EC-/Postcard, cash or payments in advance (Post account 46-8559-7) are the only acceptable methods of payment (no credit cards).
- 7. The try-out weekend, the 3-day-course or the basic course include the training on the training hill and 1, 3 or 10 altitude flights depending on the course type including the rental of the equipment (exclusive shoes). The duration of the course depends on the weather conditions but is limited to maximum 3 months.
- 8. The package includes the basic training on the training hill and all necessary altitude flights till the licence as well as all equipment (exclusive shoes) up to the 10th altitude flight. The duration of the course depends on the weather conditions but is limited to maximum 6, 12 or 18 months depending on the booked variant. By timely notice <u>before</u> the interruption of the course due to unavoidable interferences such as illness, accident or extended trips abroad that make regular attendance impossible, an extension may be granted. The interruption starts with the date of announcement. Course extensions after the interruptions are not free anymore. At the end of the training period, a fee for continuation is payable according to the current price list. At the end of the course period or in case of termination of the training all claims on fees paid are voided.
- 9. All further expenses such as exam fees, cable-car and transport costs, and equipment rental from the 11th altitude flight onwards are payable separately by the course participant.
- 10. For participation in the trainings on the training hill, an advance booking (telephone or E-Mail) is always necessary. Altitude flights are to be booked on the automatic recording service (after the beep) between 18:00 to 20:00 the evening before. Training flights only take place if sufficient bookings have been received.
- 11. The trainee pilot is obligated to read the document "Information and Rules for Trainee Pilots" and to behave accordingly.
- 12. Otherwise the General Business Rules (AGB) apply. They can be found on the school internet site.
